*Nordplus Junior project "Global Goals Enquiry" in Latvia, April 8–12, 2019*



The aim of the project is to educate students at secondary level to be globally engaged citizens and to prepare them for the 21st century.

In cooperation with five VET institutions from Baltic and Nordic countries, Careeria QBA students Asafu-Adjaye Ruth, Sunny Shil, Wanirwoth Daisy, Kipkemei Andrew and Islam MD Shamiul were discovering *Global Goal 12 – Responsible Consumption and Production*.

The students discussed Sustainable Consumption and Production in order to promote resource and energy efficiency and sustainable infrastructure by providing access to basic services, green and decent jobs and a better quality of life for all. They came to the conclusion that there are many ways to help to reduce future economic, environmental and social costs, strengthen economic competitiveness and reduce poverty.

During the workshop, the students practiced their Learning Power within dimensions such as curiosity, creativity, reflection, collaboration and mindful agency. They went through the five stages of the enquiry process exploring the Global Goals and discussing them in teams. Thereafter, they came up with practical solutions that each person could implement in their own lives to promote resource and energy efficiency and sustainable consumption and production.
