

EMPOWERMENT FOR BEING INNOVATIVE – NORDPLUS MOBILITY WEEK IN CAREERIA OCTOBER 7–11, 2019

Careeria hosted the first mobility week of newly started Nordplus Junior project **Empowerment by Innovation - a must for inclusion**. Topic of week 7–11 October 2019 was *“Different generations – Same challenges – Equal opportunities”*.

Schools participating with Careeria are TTK University of Applied Sciences, Institute of Service Economy (Estonia), Nyköpings gymnasium (Sweden), Vilnius Vocational Training Centre of Technology and Business (Lithuania), the comprehensive college in Akureyri (Iceland), Nyköpings gymnasium Nico (Sweden) and AARHUS TECH (Denmark).

The students did various tasks and presentations about challenges of life different generations (old, middle-aged, young) had when they were young and how they tackled them. Group work and presentations happened in mixed international groups.

We had a nice three-day meeting from Tuesday to Thursday with our guests from Estonia, Lithuania, Denmark, Sweden and Iceland. All countries had sent a group of four students and one teacher to participate this thematic week.

From Careeria staff participants were Business and Administration students from group FM2018 and teachers Bryan Roberts, Susanne Karlsson, Göran Kainberg and Jukka Hakala. The group FM2018 had also participated the programme planning and implementation as part of their event management study module. Students did various tasks and presentations in mixed international groups.
